

Destinations

We work proactively to support our School leavers in their progression onto further education, training and employment. Data captured in January 2019 of the activity of our recent 2018 cohort, indicate that 95% have continued in further education and 5% progressed onto Apprenticeship programs for Year 11. For Year 13 cohort, 60% went into Higher Education, 18% moved onto a Higher/Degree Apprenticeships, 21% went into employment and 1% was considered to be not in education, employment or training (NEET).
