**Curriculum Overview:** Pupils follow the AQA syllabus for GCSE English Language and English Literature. All pupils will be entered for both subjects (4 exams in total) and submit a non-assessed speaking and listening presentation. The content for the two course has been studied during Year 9 (Macbeth) and in Year 10, meaning Year 11 is used as a revision year and as a way to heighten engagement with the content.

## Topic Studied- Term 1

AQA GCSE English Literature – we begin by thoroughly revising Macbeth and then move onto revising An Inspector Calls and A Christmas Carol.

AQA GCSE English Language – Revision of language paper 2 exam will take place, which covers reading and writing skills.

## Topic Studied- Term 2

Mock feedback  
After completing mock exams in the previous term, there will be acute feedback given to each class on every exam area.  
Teachers will tackle each area of language and literature and support pupils in making improvements to their responses.  
Once mock feedback lessons are completed, revision will focus on English Language paper 1 and Macbeth in preparation for their second Mock in February.  
Post Feb Mock Unseen Poetry is taught – the final Literature component for this cohort.

## Topic Studied- Term 3

As final exams approach, pupils will revise multiple areas of the course in lessons. February mock feedback will also inform this.

## Assessments:

AQA exam style reading and writing assessments take place each term. On top of this there will also be spelling tests and subject terminology tests.

## Homework:

Homework is set each week by the class teacher. In the case where a class has more than one teacher it is the teacher the pupils see most who sets the homework. Pupils should also be spending time reading at home to support their literacy skills.

## Other Useful Information:

Throughout the year we have events such as Master Classes and Examiner workshops to support pupils with their exam preparation. We also have a Parental Support Evening where members of the faculty are on hand to advise and provide resources to support with revision. This may well be pre-recorded this year dependent on when current restrictions are lifted.
